INTO Mason's Learning Resource Center can help multilingual students that instructors believe are struggling academically due to difficulties comprehending and/or using English. INTO Mason will also provide English language support services to multilingual members of the Mason community through tutoring and regular workshops related to grammar, writing, pronunciation, and speaking.

Moreover, teaching assistants whose first language is not English must register with the LRC to take the Classroom English Language Teaching Demonstration ([CELTD](#)), which measures their ability to communicate clearly and effectively in spoken English. Students who do not pass the assessment are required to receive 10-16 hours of tutoring before assuming instructional responsibilities and/or being permitted to retake the test. Students who provisionally pass the CELTD may be assigned instructional positions, but must concurrently receive 6 hours of English language tutoring.

All LRC tutoring is provided at a nominal cost or free-of-charge in some cases. Weekly workshops are provided free on a first-come, first-served basis. For more details regarding LRC services, contact the [INTO Mason Learning Resource Center](#).
